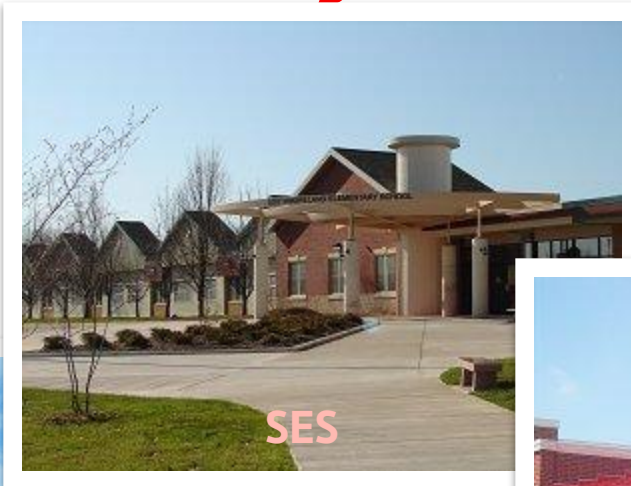


Description of the mission and what defines the purpose of the organization:


