

2017-2018 School Year:*

For attendance in all grades:

- 4 doses of tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis
 - 1 dose on or after the 4th birthday
 - usually given as DTP or DTaP or if medically advisable, DT or Td
- 4 doses of polio
 - 4th dose on or after 4th birthday and at least 6 months after previous dose given
 - A fourth dose is not necessary if the third dose was administered at age 4 years or older and at least 6 months after the previous dose
- 2 doses of measles, mumps, rubella
 - Usually given as MMR
- 3 doses of hepatitis B
- 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or evidence of immunity

For attendance in 7th grade (in addition to those written above for all grades):

- **1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap) by the first day of 7th grade**
- **1 dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV) by the first day of 7th grade**

For attendance in 12th grade (ADDITIONAL to those written above for all grades and for attendance in 7th grade):

- 1 dose of MCV before the first day of 12th grade (to make a total of 2 doses)
 - If only one dose was given and it was given at 16 years of age or older, that shall count as the twelfth grade dose
