



SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM

CURBSIDE MEAL PICK UPS

(updated 6-1-21)

We will transition to our summer meal distribution on Friday, June 4. Free Breakfast & Lunch meals for community children up to age 18 will continue to be available for pick up at the Middle School on **Fridays** until early August.

Parents may pick up 7 days of meals for their children at the Southmoreland Middle School Cafeteria double doors in the back of the building from 11:00 – 11:30 a.m. with a reservation. A limited number of meals will be available from 11:45– noon *without* a reservation. Children do not have to be present. We are following district safety protocols; **masks are presently required**. Please display the name card we give you to assist with our **contactless** pick up process. Staff will place bags in the front seat of your vehicle provided it is empty and all passengers in the car are wearing masks, otherwise, please open your trunk & assist staff. Breakfast will include an entree/grain, juice or fruit and 1/2 pint 1% white milk. Lunch will include an entree (protein with grain), 3/4 c total fruit &/or vegetable and milk. Additional entrées may be frozen &/or require heating at home. Please consume or store perishable items A.S.A.P/ within two hours of pick up. Please reheat any items to 165 degrees. Each child is eligible to receive a gallon of milk; you may refuse all or some of the milk if you prefer.

Reservations are required by noon on WEDNESDAYS. Please complete a google form available on the district home page (www.southmoreland.net) each week you plan to pick up. Find the link for “Summer Meal Reservations” under “Announcements” or under Food Service. It is best to use a computer rather than a phone to make reservations if you wish to receive an e-mail confirmation.

Over 900,000 children in the state qualify for additional P-EBT funds. The PA Department of Human Services has already started distributing these funds, the district does not distribute them. Forms for 2021-2022 will be available in July.

Your continued patience and understanding is appreciated as we adapt to changing regulations and guidelines while dealing with district logistical challenges and maintaining program accountability and integrity. If your children will receive meals at another site or part of any summer enrichment program, they are NOT eligible for the 7 day meal pick-up. We plan to publicize the tentative menu, but it is very subject to change as we deal with manufacturing & supply chain issues and other logistics.
