Guidelines for the Eugene "Babe" Fabrizi Fund to Educate Music Students

To provide scholarships for young or adult musicians.

The following criteria will apply:

- 1. Pursue a degree or studies in: Majoring in Music or Pursuing a Music or Musical Theatre Concentration in Higher Education
- 2. Use scholarship at: Carnegie Mellon University, Duquesne University, Point Park University, University of Pittsburgh.
- 3. Complete an application.
- 4. Maintain a GPA of: 2.00
- 5. Write and submit an essay: A one page essay highlighting why you have chosen your particular field of music.

Final selection of the scholarship winners will be decided (subject to the approval of the Board of Directors of The Pittsburgh Foundation) by a Scholarship Advisory Committee of The Pittsburgh Foundation. The Advisory Committee consists of three to five persons from the community at large. *No member of the Advisory Committee, or his or her immediate family, is eligible for scholarship assistance during his or her tenure on the Advisory Committee.*

The Pittsburgh Foundation shall notify the chosen scholarship recipient(s) of its decision. The scholarship payment will be made annually after The Pittsburgh Foundation's June Board Meeting, and after the selected student notifies the Foundation about the school he or she will be attending. Payment will be made to the school for the student.
