Health & Safety Plan

On June 25, the School Board approved the Health & Safety plan that was developed to ensure ongoing communication with families around the elements of the local Health and Safety Plan. This plan will be posted on the school district website.

Communication & Awareness

Signs promoting everyday protective measures and describing how to stop the spread of germs (such as proper handwashing and face coverings) will be posted in highly visible areas
