



## **Southmoreland School District Logistics Fact Sheet 4**



### **The Favorite Times of the School Day**

Time during the school day when students get to socialize and engage in activities that are meaningful for them in a setting relatively free of adult control.

### **Meals/Cafeteria**

Breakfast and lunches will be served in the cafeteria with students sitting at least 6-feet apart and wearing face coverings when walking to and from the cafeteria as well as when getting their food. Students will be seated in staggered arrangements to avoid "across-the-table" seating.

Individual bagged breakfast and lunches will be served.  
If students are bringing lunch to school, it must be in a disposable bag.

Students are to report to the cafeteria in the morning **ONLY** if they are eating breakfast. All other students are to report to either their designated area, homeroom, or first period class.

### **Recess**

Recess will still be offered to students, outdoors when possible. Students will not be able to use the playground equipment due to our inability to disinfect as necessary. Students will follow social distancing guidelines. Teachers will have planned activities such as jump rope, hula hoops, jumping, running, sidewalk chalk, etc. for students to choose from. Students are not to bring personal items from home.

### **Physical Education**

Grade K-1 will be held in homeroom. Grades 2-12 will be structured, non-contact activities in the gym or classroom. Students will not be permitted to change clothes.
