



Southmoreland School District Transportation Fact Sheet



Busing and Transportation

To the greatest extent possible, there will be only one student per seat.

Family units may choose to sit together.

Students who have other means of getting to and from school are encouraged to use those options.

Opening of windows when feasible will help mitigate the spread of the virus.

Driving passes are available at the HS Main Office.

Face Coverings

Riders are required to wear a face covering (in accordance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act or IDEA) to board the bus and are expected to wear the face covering the entire ride.

Cleaning & Disinfection

School buses will be deep cleaned and sanitized daily - after morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up runs are complete. High-contact surfaces will be disinfected between each bus run.

Assigned Seats

Students must remain in the same seat for the entire ride. If necessary, seats will be assigned.

Students will board the bus from back to front and exit the bus from front to back.

Bus Passes

NO bus passes will be issued. **NO** exceptions.

Please remember that transportation is a privilege and not a right.
