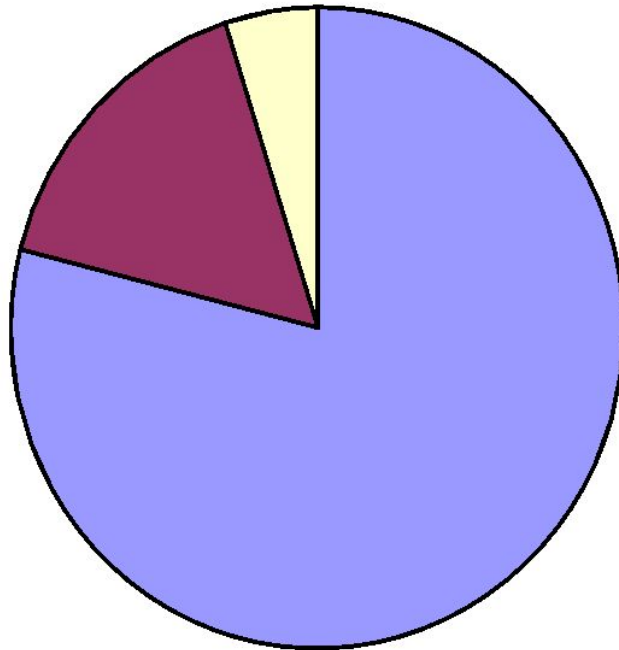

BREAKDOWN OF TITLE I BUDGET



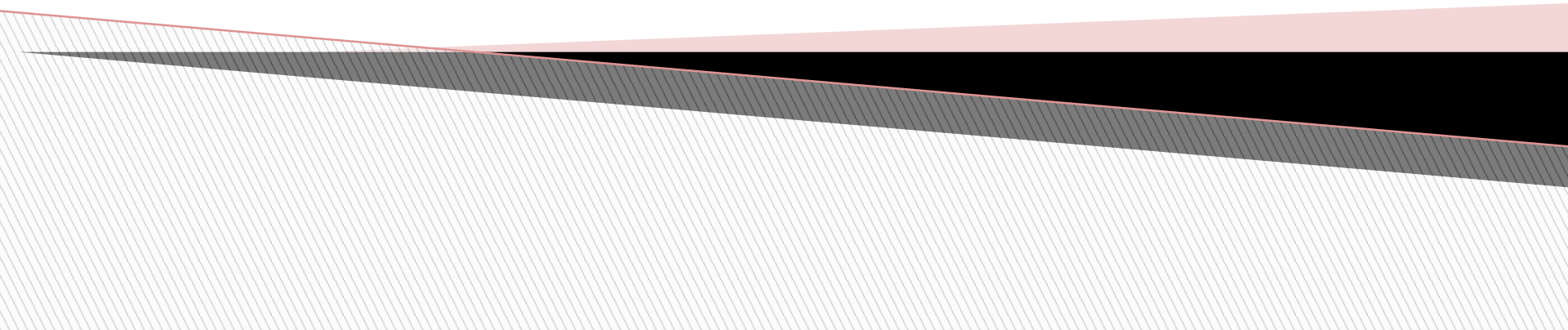

TITLE I

- CONTINUE TO PROVIDE READING AND MATH SERVICES IN PRIMARY GRADES, WITH EMPHASIS ON EARLY INTERVENTION AND SKILL BUILDING. IMPLEMENTATION OF 95% GROUP, ECRI AND CORE READING SERIES AS WELL AS SCREENERS TO IDENTIFY GROUP AND STUDENT NEEDS.
- TITLE I PROGRAMMING HAS BEEN ADDED IN UPPER GRADES TO PROVIDE INTERVENTION IN READING AND IN LITERACY. ACADEMIC SUPPORT FOR ALL STUDENTS IS PROVIDED THROUGH SCOTTIE BLOCK TIME DURING THE SCHOOL DAY.
