In French II, students will be able to talk about the past using the four modes of communication.

Module Titles:

Module Overviews:

Module 1: Conduct a complete café/restaurant conversation during which discuss food options, place an order, ask for and pay the bill.

Utilizing the four modes of communication (speaking, listening, reading, writing,) students will engage in the topics of courtesy expressions, Food and beverage vocabulary, Offering/accepting/refusing food, Exchanging opinions, Partitive vs. indefinite articles, Forming commands (Imperative), French dining customs, Euro currency

Module 2: Shop for clothing

Utilizing the four modes of communication (speaking, listening, reading, writing,) students will engage in the topics of clothing vocabulary, offering and asking for help, asking about and giving prices, and making a decision

Module 3: Inquire about and relate past events

Utilizing the four modes of communication (speaking, listening, reading, writing,) students will engage in the topics of clothing and shopping, Past tense formation (passé compose with avoir), purpose of helping verbs and past participles

Module 4:Inquire about and relate past events

Utilizing the four modes of communication (speaking, listening, reading, writing,) students will engage in the topics of home or apartment life, Past tense formation (passé compose with être), purpose of helping verbs and past participles
