French III Overview:

In French III, students will be able to utilize object pronouns and reflexive verbs using the four modes of communication.

Module Titles:

Module 1: Inquire about and express enthusiasm, indifference, and dissatisfaction with an outcome.

Module 2: Utilize direct and indirect object pronouns within the context of both present and past situations.

Module 3: Describe daily routines/occurrences through the use of reflexive and non-reflexive verbs in the past, present, and immediate future tenses.

Module Overviews:

Module 1: Inquire about and express enthusiasm, indifference, and dissatisfaction with an outcome.

Utilizing the four modes of communication (speaking, listening, reading, writing,) students will engage in the topics of information question formation, Passé composé with Avoir & Être verbs, Direct & indirect object pronouns, Thematic vocabulary, Forms of *Quelque chose* and *Quelqu'un* in positive vs. negative context, Adjective agreement, Agreement of past participle w/DOP's

Module 2: Utilize direct and indirect object pronouns within the context of both present and past situations.

Utilizing the four modes of communication (speaking, listening, reading, writing,) students will engage in the topics of Giving advice, Information question formation, Verification of completed tasks, Indirect & direct object pronoun placement, the pronouns *y* and *en*, Sentence negation, Present indicative & passé composé, Past participle agreement w/DOP's

Module 3: Describe daily routines/occurrences through the use of reflexive and non-reflexive verbs in the past, present, and immediate future tenses.

Utilizing the four modes of communication (speaking, listening, reading, writing,) students will engage in the topics of daily routine, using reflexive and non-reflexive verbs, talking about their day.
