## **Internet and Social Media Overview:**

We will cover core Internet technologies, Web page design, authoring, computational thinking, networking fundamentals and technology planning. ## **Module Overviews:**

### **Module 1: Learning HTML**

In this module, students will learn how to change the font, add images, save images to the correct folder, put a background on a webpage and the difference in file extensions. They will read, analyze, and determine the difference in the HTML tags. Finally, they will apply their knowledge by creating a basic webpage using HTML.

### **Module 2: Designing in Adobe Photoshop**

In this module, students will learn how to change the font, add images, save images to the correct folder, put a background on a PS canvas and have multiple layers. They will read, analyze, and determine the difference in tools, layers, menus and styles. Finally, they will apply their knowledge by creating a basic cutout using their own pictures, a cartoon face, halloween projects and more.

### **Module 3: Special Effects with Text in Photoshop**

In this module, students will learn to use different techniques to create special text images for titles on their webpage. They will read, analyze, and determine the difference between blending options, layer styles and layer window. Finally, they will apply their knowledge by creating a variety of different text effects for webpage titles.



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## **Module 4: Social Media Applications and Digital Citizenship**

In this module, students will learn to use different social media techniques and how to journey safely through their digital citizenship. They will read, analyze, and determine the impact of Cybersecurity. Finally, they will apply their knowledge by creating a Public Service Announcement.
